**MACT AGM - May 4th, 2019**

**Since my last report in 2018, I have attended three meetings with the CSCT Board of Directors. I currently serve as the Provincial Director for Manitoba as well as a member of the CSCT Nominations Committee and the point person for CSCT Bylaws and Policies. I have enjoyed working with the CSCT Board and being involved in decisions to make our Society better for all members. It is very interesting to see what other provinces are doing, talking with other directors and gaining ideas for our own province.**

**Recently, the CSCT sent out a member survey and I hope you all had the opportunity to participate and earn the 5 CEUs that were offered. A list of participants has been sent to MACT as verification for CEU purposes.**

**The Honorary CSCT President for 2019 is Dr. Igal Sebaq from Montreal, Quebec.**

**The CSCT Board and Committees have been very busy with projects over the past year including:**

- **Providing new Provincial Registrars and Treasurers with step by step information on how to update their database for the upcoming end of the 2017-2019 triennium.**
- **Implementing a Communications Committee in which Linda McLean was chosen to serve on.**
- **Naming a new chair, Sarah Meyers, to the CSCT Exam Committee, replacing long-time chair Lynn Zinger – who will stay on the committee with a focus on Cardiology Technology programs.**
- **More work is being done on the CSCT National Exam with a psychometrician determining the passing score with new edited questions.**
- **The CSCT has a new CEU Committee Chair, April Forrest. It was the goal of CSCT to have all provinces participate on this committee with the Provincial Education or CEU Coordinators as members. I am happy**

**to say our PEC is a member of this committee and able to provide ideas and feedback.**

- **There has been a schedule change for the future CCC meetings. Typically, they have been held from a Saturday to Tuesday and now will be held on a Thursday to Sunday. The 2019 CCC will be held on October 24<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> in Montreal with the CSCT Education Day on Friday the 25<sup>th</sup> and the AGM on Saturday the 26<sup>th</sup>. There will be a dinner on the 26<sup>th</sup> for full conference participants.**
- **E-Transfer for payment of dues is becoming popular in most other provinces and is preferred to PayPal.**
- **CSCT is awaiting guidelines on the National Occupational Competency Profile revision process.**
- **If a member requires proof of registration and membership cards are not available at that time, a letter can be requested from the CSCT until the card is printed.**
- **Accreditation Canada has taken over the function of program accreditation from the Canadian Medical Association.**
- **New Life Member nomination forms are now available on the CSCT website. The newest Life Member, Michelle Reynolds, was announced at the 2018 AGM in Toronto.**
- **A new Reinstatement Policy will take effect and be on the CSCT website as of January 2020.**
- **The next CSCT Board of Directors meeting that I will be attending is to be held in Halifax in June 2019, with one extra day dedicated to reviewing the policies and bylaws of the Society.**
